The CISEC Program

As a non-profit 501(c)6 organization, CISEC, Inc. administers its professional certification program to recognize the abilities, skills, experience and knowledge of inspectors who demonstrate their proficiency to observe, inspect and report on sediment and erosion control methods installed on construction sites.

CISEC, Inc. provides two comprehensive sediment and erosion and stormwater pollutant control inspector programs.

- Individuals not having at least 2-years of sediment and erosion control inspection experience can earn an “In-Training” (CISEC-IT) designation and certificate by attending our 1½-day long training modules and passing the **Level 1** one and one-half hour examination by 75% or better.
- Once a CISEC-IT accumulates at least 2-years of inspection experience, they can qualify as a CISEC Registrant by passing the **Level 2** examination by 75% or better. The **Level 2** examination is reserved solely for CISEC-ITs that have receive approval from CISEC, Inc. to sit for the test.
- Individuals with two or more years of sediment and erosion control inspection experience can qualify as a CISEC Registrant by passing the **Level 3** examination by 75% or better:

Those seeking to sit for the **Level 3** examination must receive approval from CISEC, Inc. The comprehensive 3½-hour certification examination will include questions from the following topics:

- EPA rules and regulations that impact inspectors,
- Knowledge about BMPs and pollutants,
- BMP inspection requirements,
- Assessing construction sites for compliance,
- Analyzing a S&EC plan,
- Identifying noncompliance conditions and
- Writing inspection reports.

Low Impact Development Courses

1. Low Impact Development Annual Inspection and Maintenance Course

Description: This one-day course is designed for contractors and other individuals who inspect and maintain post-construction Low Impact Development (LID) permanent stormwater best management practices. There are two options for this course including a non-certification option and an option for a Certification Credential by successfully passing the certification exam with a score of 75% or better. Both course options include an optional field trip on Wednesday.

- Course: Sunday, September 17th from 8:00am - 4:30pm

2. Low Impact Development Construction Inspection Course

Description: This one-day registration course is customized for design professionals and other individuals who construct and perform construction inspections of Low Impact Development (LID) permanent stormwater best management practices. There are two options for this course including a non-credential seeking option and an option for a Registration Credential by successfully passing the course exam with a score of 75% or better.

- Course: Sunday, September 17th from 8:00am - 4:30pm
