3. Participants notified of approved project abstracts must submit the final electronic project poster and a 5-minute video presentation to Suzanna Perea (perea.suzanna@epa.gov) no later than 11:59 PM CDT on July 27, 2020 for judging.
4. Project presenters must be present during the competition poster session event on August 11th and be available for additional questions from attendees. To participate in this event, presenters must pay a \$50 entry fee (\$25 for students). There is no fees for poster session presenters who have paid for conference admission.
